

Force Motors introduces new Gurkha Xtreme

New Delhi: Force Motors on Monday has introduced the Gurkha Xtreme powered by the Mercedes OM 611 derived common rail engine.

It is also the only vehicle that comes with differential locks on both front and rear axles to come out of sticky situations, and air intake snorkel for deep water wading, the company said in a statement.

Ashutosh Khosla, President Sales and Marketing, Force Motors said, "The Gurkha Xtreme is being introduced in a phased manner with the first lot of vehicles being delivered to select customers who have been waiting since long for this variant."

"With the introduction of the Gurkha Xtreme, our portfolio of off-roading vehicles is complete with variants to take care of every segment, be it mild, moderate or extreme off-roading," he added.

It also comes with a new transfer case and a new live rigid axle in the front.

The exterior of the vehicle has undergone a facelift with a bold new front fascia, unique bonnet mounted LED indicators, new front, and rear steel bumpers which add significantly to the style quotient of the vehicle.

The signature chrome finish air intake snorkel, muscular side cladding, new attractive bold graphics, clear lens headlamps, front fog lamps, large ORVMs, sturdy and full-length slip resistant footboard, and increased width all-terrain tubeless tyres are standard.
